TABLE OF FEES

Ickleton Cemetery, Brookhampton Street, Ickleton, Cambridgeshire

Legal Basis

These fees are set under:

- Local Government Act 1972 (Section 214 and Schedule 26)
- Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977

Ickleton Parish Council is the Burial Authority for the Parish of Ickleton.

The following fees were agreed at the Council meeting held on **18th February 2026**.

Eligibility

The person being buried, or the person in respect of whom burial rights are granted, must have been before death:

- A past or present resident

Periods spent away from the parish due to residence in a care home, hospital, or similar do not count as absence.

If this eligibility is not met, Exclusive Right of Burial and Interment fees will be charged at three times the standard rate.

All decisions are at the discretion of the Parish Council.

Part 1: Exclusive right of burial

(Plot purchase – valid for 99 years)

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| • Earthen grave (2m x 1m) | £300 |
| • Double-depth earthen grave (2m x 1m) | £480 |
| • Cremated remains grave (600mm x 600mm) | £180 |
| • Double-depth cremated remains grave (600mm x 600mm) | £300 |

Part 2: Interment

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|---|-------------|
| • Interment (burial) | £300 |
| • Interment of ashes | £120 |
| • Interment of ashes in an existing family grave where Exclusive Right of Burial has already been granted | £120 |

Important notes:

- These fees do not include grave digging.
 - Fees for child burials (17 years or under) or cremations are not charged to families. Local Authority fees are met through Government funding.
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Part 3: Monuments, gravestones, tablets and monumental inscriptions

Fees apply for permission to erect or place a memorial on a grave where the Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted:

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|---|-------------|
| • Headstone (maximum height 3 feet) | £150 |
| • Kerbing (in line with memorial conditions) | £150 |
| • Vase-style monument (maximum height 12 inches) | £120 |
| • Memorial plaque for interment of ashes | £120 |
| • Additional memorial plaque on existing grave
(e.g. for interment of ashes) | £120 |
| • Any additional inscription after the first | £120 |

Conditions:

- Headstones may not be erected until **at least six months after burial**.
- All memorial designs and inscriptions must be **approved by the Parish Council** before installation.
- No changes may be made to an existing memorial without prior approval of the Parish Council and written consent from the Clerk.
- Current memorial guidelines must be followed for all applications.

Services by a minister of religion

- Full service *By arrangement with the Minister*
- Interment service *By arrangement with the Minister*

Removal of human remains

- Licence issued under Section 25 of the Burial Act 1857
for removal of human remains **£300**
